Mission Statement

"To improve, promote and display quality New Zealand Velvet and Hard Antler nationally and internationally through competition"

Competition Rules

- 1. All velvet/hard antler must have a Veltrack Tag No.
- 2. All entries at the owners risk. Please protect your velvet and hard antler heads for courier.
- 3. All velvet will be judged according to Industry Agreed Velvet Grading Guidelines.
- 4. A completed copy of the entry form must be emailed no later than Tuesday 10th December. Another copy must accompany the velvet.
- 5. ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID prior to judging for heads to be eligible for the competition.
- 6. All enteries must have identification on each stick of velvet or antier and match the information on the entry form that has been submitted. USE THE CUT OFF STRIPS FROM THE OTHER SIDE OF THIS FORM and Include Veltrack tag no.
- 7. Velvet and hard antler must be in the PGG Wrightson freezer Invercargill by noon Tuesday 10th December 2024.
- 8. Velvet/Hard Antler must be of this calendar year's crop.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to disqualify any velvet that is overgrown, damaged, or not frozen and will not display such velvet.
- 10. All heads must be grown in New Zealand and the animals able to be inspected at the judges and the committee's discretion.
- 11. Hard Antler must be fully dry Red, Elk/Wapiti or Fallow type and non-odorous.
- 12. Three year old Elk/Wapiti Supreme velvet is eligible for the 3 year old class.
- 13. All Elk/Wapiti supreme must be of no less than 20cm between bez and trez.
- 14. The Restricted Southland Section is for velvet grown in Southland from Sections 1, 2, 4, 5 & 7. Once the velvet from any given stag has won this section his velvet is not eligible for entry in this section in future.
- 15. Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 16. Entrants must be fully paid members of DFA or EWS.
- 17. The Judges reserve the right to penalise any malformed heads.
- 18. Minimum of three heads to run any section.
- 19. There is a 3% cut off between the two Elk Wapiti Hard Antler classes. Class classifications for Elk typical and non-typical. 0 to 2.99%. Typical anything over 3% should be Non-Typical. Which is different to internationally recognized scoring.
- 20. All Hard Antler is scored in Inches of Antler (IOA).

Packaging and Transport

Velvet should be packaged in suitable containers and be serviceable for the return journey. Refrigerated road freight will be provided by our sponsor PGG Wrightson. Contact your local PGG Wrightson branch for details and deadlines. Please supply clear instructions and responsibility for the velvet/antler return.

Results and trophy presentations will take place at the Awards Dinner, Ascot Park on Saturday evening the 14th of December 2024.

All velvet and hard antler will be on display at the Awards Dinner from 5.15p.m.
