Rules and Special Conditions

- All entries at owners risk.
- Please respect all velvet guidelines
- All velvet will be judged according to Industry agreed velvet grading guidelines.
- All entries must have identification on each piece of velvet (DINZ tag) and this must match the information on the entry form.
- Include clear instructions for the handling agent and responsibility for the return of the velvet to the owner.
- Judges decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Judges may disqualify any velvet manipulated in any way to fit weight classes.
- The committee reserves the right to disqualify any velvet.
- Velvet/hard antler must be of this year's crop i.e. cut after last year's competition.
- Hard Antler will be measured using a CI score (Competition inches). IOA
- All entrants must be financial members of the NZDFA.
- Heads for classes 3a, 3b, 8, 14 and 15 are not eligible for any other classes.
- Elk/Wapiti Supreme velvet is not eligible for the class 2.
- To be eligible to enter the 'Local Maiden Red' class, the stag must not have had a placing in any previous competition.
